A young Marine was starting his journey back to Infantry training at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. He had just completed 30 days leave after basic training at Parris Island. His mother volunteered to drive him up to Newark airport to fly back to base. He was happy to accept the offer, but he requested to be dropped off a day early so that his mother would not miss a day of work.

He told her his story, and her reply was this,

"I am not going to let a Marine stay overnight in a corridor at this airport. I want you to come with me."

She took him to the pilots lounge of her airline, and told all in that place that this young Marine was her guest, and that he would be spending the night in the lounge until it was time for him to check onto his flight with the other airline.

In Matthew 25:35, Jesus said this, "For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me." In Hebrews 13:2 The Bible states "Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels."

I know the Marine is mortal, but maybe, just maybe, the attendant was an angel. We will never know, but I know kindness when I see it, and this was an act of kindness to our brother. Semper Fi Marine!


ANNOUNCEMENTS
