## HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE MARCH DETACHMENT MEETING

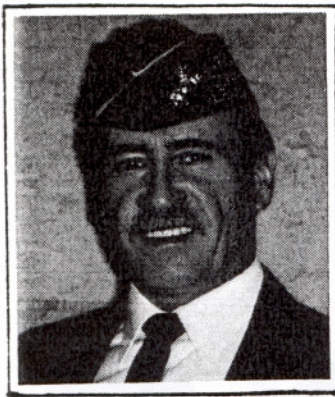


