This is a Service Pistol and Open Pistol Match, competitors in different classes will be given different color score cards. The Match rules will follow the NRA service pistol 25yd match. The open match will run under the same rules, except weapon type is any CENTER fire weapon larger than .22 cal. and up to .50 cal. All competitors must be 18 years old on the date of the event, sign a release and hold harmless agreement and supply their own ammo. The cost for each shooter is \$30, if you wish to shoot both matches, the cost will be \$45. Registration must be done by Sept. 28th 2015 and the match will be limited to 160 shooters. The forms and hold harmless agreements are available at www.mclcb.org and information on submitting the forms will be there as well. Scores from the service match will be eligible for the MCL National Postal Match as long as the shooter is a member in good standing in the Marine Corps League and pays the \$10 fee, more details will be available at the event. This match is sponsored by the Central Bucks Detachment, the Department of Pennsylvania Marine Corps League, the and the MCL Foundation of PA.
