### HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE JULY MEETING

- \* Sixteen members were present including all officers and one visitor.
- \* Minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted along with the paymasters report.
- \* Don Gee will check on the tax exempt forms and license requirements of the County and State that are needed for fund raising events sponsored by the Detachment

### NEWS FROM THE CONVENTION ....

- \* Fran Meyers reported on some of the events that transpired at the State Convention. Fifty-one scholarships were awarded by the scholarship committee of which twelve were in the Southeast Division. These are four year scholarships to colleges or universities with a monetary value of \$250 each, per year. The total sales for the State Car Raffle amounted to \$26,850 which covered the cost of car and other prizes with the balance, after expenses, being used to fund the scholarship grants.
- \* The Detachment Scrapbook placed second in the State competition primarily due to the fact that there was no mention of any VAVS activity by the members, which was an unfortunate oversight.3 However. the Scrapbook Committee did a fantastic job with our entry and can be very proud of their accomplishment. The Detachment Newsletter also placed second ,in the State, and lost the top spot apparently because the format was not consistent with the guidelines set forth by the State Committee. All we can say is that we'll try harder next time. Plaques were awarded to the Detachment and an individual award was made to the Newsletter Editor.
- \* The Young Marines were in attendance at the convention. They presented the colors and provided escorts for the ladies to their tables. Another commendable job by this young and ambitious group
- \* During an address by the Sgt. Major Overstreet, Sgt. Major of the Marine Corps. he characterized the Marine Corps as follows: "THE MARINES ARE THE NATION'S 911". Certainly a fitting description if I ever heard one.

### PUBLIC RELATIONS

- \* The Detachment voted to continue with their application to participate in the "Adopt-A-Highway program through PennDOT. Twelve volunteers will be needed to assist with the clean-up which will probably be in the fall. Mike Waldron will finalize the details. If you can lend a hand for a few hours, on the Saturday that is chosen please contact Mike.
- \* Don Parzanese reported that the Detachment will be receiving a check for \$177.04 from Genuardi's Market for cash register receipts that have been collected and turned in to Don. This is such an easy way to make money so please collect as many as possible and turn them in.

- \* POW/MIA... Bill Plant spoke briefly about a certain individual who has expressed a desire to go to Asia to check on POW/MIA's. However, Bill indicated that he did not want to see this person represent the League and that the Dept. of Penna. had refused to pay any of his expenses for the trip.
- \* MARINE OF THE YEAR.... Bill Plant was appointed as committee chairman for the coming year.
- \* VAVS..... Don Gee has scheduled a meeting with the Philadelphia Veterans Hospital staff people to obtain information on activities that they feel would be of benefit to the patients.

### \* NEW BUSINESS

It was agreed to leave the detachment by-laws as they now exist concerning the appointment rather than election of the adjutant. A proposal will be made at the National Convention, in August, concerning a switch from white shirt to khaki to be worn with dress blues.

### \* OLD BUSINESS

Don Parzanese reported that he had received information the regulations concerning fund raising for a home association. There would be no tax on any funds until they exceed \$25,000. He will have more information on this later.

- \* Mike Waldron will obtain tickets for future Philly Pops concerts to be held in Sept. and Nov. at the Keswick Theater, in Glenside, Pa.
- \* Don't forget to bring in any old clothing that you may have to give to Bill Haas to take to Philly for the needy and homeless.
- \* There will be another "Breakfast at Fran's Pub", for the public, on October 3rd. More on that later.
- \* We had a nice turnout for the Fourth of July parade in New Britain. A total of sixteen members were present and accounted for with two extra riders on the float. Maybe next year we can double that count since we have signed up for 1993, already.




