Highlights

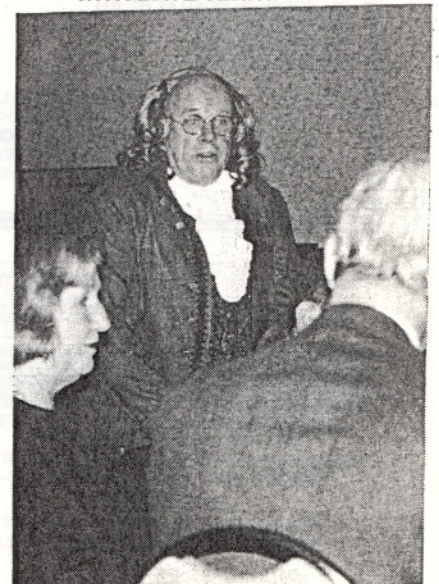
