# SOUTHEAST DIVISION HOLDS MEETING IN BRISTOL

Southeast Division Vice Commandant Charles Shaw called the meeting to order at 2:05 p.m. at the U.S Army Reserve Center, Bristol, PA, on September 7, 1996.

Roll Call of Officers present: Shaw, SE Division Assistant Vice Commandants Tom Tanner and Daniel Doty.

Roll Call of Detachments present: All Divisions, Central Bucks, Chester County, Hugh B. Eastburn III, Gen. Smedley D. Butler, Manatawny, Northampton County, Penndelphia, and Valley Forge. Nine Detachments and 23 members present.

Commandant Shaw introduced National and Department officers: National Commandant Paul Seton, Past National Commandant Lamar Golden, National Uniform Chairman Jim Cruz, National Budget Committee member John Moyses, Department Adjutant Paul Seton, Department Judge Advocate John Moyses, Department Chaplain Tom Tanner, and Assistant SE Division Vice Commandant Dan Doty.

Commandant Shaw introduced National Commandant Seton who thanked Shaw for the great job he has done and for all of the help he has been in the past and for what he will do in the future. Seton then reported on the National Convention. Seton stated 57 By-Laws changes were brought to the floor at the Convention. Thirteen of these changes pertained to the "khaki shirt issue." All were soundly defeated. IT IS STILL ILLEGAL TO WEAR KHAKI SHIRTS WITH MARINE CORPS LEAGUE UNIFORMS. The Memorial Service went well, stated Seton. However, National Chaplain Bill Davis was missed at the Service. The Devil Dogs will hold their Initiation and Growl on Wednesday nights during future National Conventions rather than on Thursdays. The National Scholarship Program awarded 152 scholarships of \$300 each. Marine Nick Hawkey of Schuylkill-Carbon Detachment was named National "Marine of the Year." The All Occasion Card and Address Label Programs are doing fine, according to Seton, but he asks that we continue to support these programs. To date, no

National Merchandise Manager has been appointed. The 1997 National Convention is scheduled to be held in Nashville, TN, and the 1998 Convention is slated for New York. Marine Corps League membership is at 43,816. Commandant Seton related a story about a detachment in Lynchburg, VA, which is only five years old and has 638 members. When asked how they did it, Seton replied that they do not take no for an answer. Commandant Seton requested that the Department of Pennsylvania push recruiting and try to get back those members who have dropped out. It was asked if we could get together with Reserve Units for recruiting. Seton explained a Marine Corps program now in the works that will help along these lines.

The Chaplain asked for the names of members sick or in distress. Cards were passed around for Bill Davis, W. Frank Richardson and Thomas Dougherty.

## Detachment Reports:

**All Divisions** - No report.

**Gen. Smedley D. Butler** - There will be an Open House at the Navy Yard on Sept. 30. The Detachment will have a Color Guard. They want to preserve the history of the Yard.

**Central Bucks** - The Central Bucks Unit of the Auxiliary is up and running and will be chartered on Oct. 8.

**Chester County** - An Open House is being held on Oct. 6 from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. to dedicate the Detachment's new Home.

**Hugh B. Eastburn III** - Held a family picnic and are planning for the Birthday Ball and Veterans Day activities. They have 60 members.

**Manatawny** - Operation Holiday, a community needy program, is underway. Detachment has 84 members.

**Northampton County** - The Detachment is forming a new Firing Squad.

**Penndelphia** - They have recruited seven young members. The Young Marines Unit is doing well. The Penndelphia Scholarship Foundation is doing a great job and has presented 17 scholarships.

**Valley Forge** - They have recruited 15 new members with the help of the local Marine recruiter.

Ed Dymek suggested that the schedule for all Department meetings, especially the Convention, be sent out in advance to all detachments.

Communications were discussed. Tom Tanner suggested that all Detachments in SE Division send their newsletters to all of the other SE Division Detachments. This is a good way to share ideas and successes. If you have information which should go to all Detachments within the Department, send it to Adjutant Paul Seton for his monthly mailout.


