The glossy monthly magazine, which published its first issue 81 years ago, now can be accessed on the Internet at the Marine Corps Association's new website: www.mca-marines.org The site is called "Fire Base Leatherneck." The magazine has a diverse readership of 92,000, from junior enlisted Marines to veterans and retirees.

The Quantico, VA-based Marine Corps Association publishes the magazine along with the *Marine Corps Gazette*, a monthly journal for officers and staff noncommissioned officers.

AIRFIELD TO BE NAMED FOR GEN. CARL

ROSEBURG, OR--A retired Marine has launched a drive to have the local airfield here named after slain Marine Corps Major General Marion Carl, who was slain in his home in June 1998 while defending his wife from an armed robber.

Roseburg resident Jim Barnett, a retired First Sergeant who served under Gen. Carl, wants the airfield named in honor of the General. He started a grassroots campaign and, in August 1998, the

Roseburg City Council unanimously passed an ordinance for the new General Marion Carl Memorial Airfield. The General was an Oregon native and resided in Roseburg when he was killed.

Plans include construction of a memorial to Gen. Carl. It will be a circular plaza which will include a bronze likeness of Carl and a listing of some of his major accomplishments set in a large granite block containing the Marine Corps emblem.

The memorial will also have three lighted flagpoles--one each for the flags of the United States, the State of Oregon

and the U.S. Marine Corps. A dedication ceremony is planned for June or July 1999.

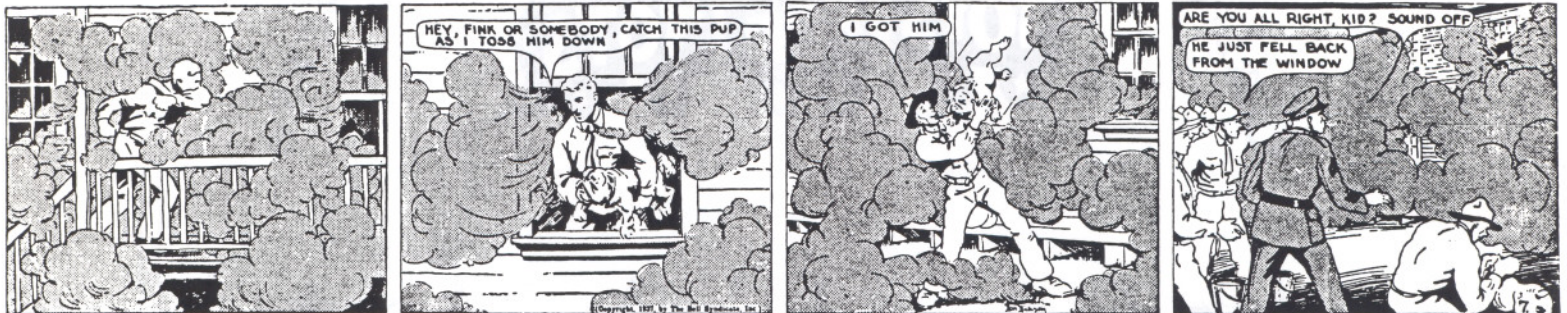
