Chalfont resident takes over public affairs post

A veteran Marine Corps combat correspondent was today appointed Public Affairs Officer for the Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center here.

Don H. Gee, a retired Marine Corps Gunnery Sergeant and recently elected National President of the Marine Corps Combat Correspondents Association, was appointed to the position by Medical Center Director Robert F. Stott in a brief ceremony at the Medical Center, located in Philadelphia's "University City" section.

His duties will include serving as spokesman for the Medical Center and developing and directing its public affairs and public relations prorams.

Prior to his new assign-

ment, Geeserved a six-year tour as the Center's Administrative Officer for Medical Research and Development.

He served as a combat correspondent and public affairs chief during his 20 years of Marine Corps service earning a Department of Defense "Thomas Jefferson Award" for newspaper excellence, a Department of the Navy Merit Award for newspaper editing, and an Armed Forces Writers League "Silver Anchor" Award for feature writing.

On Sept. 9, he was elected president of the U.S. Marine Corps Combat Correspondents Association by acclamation during the organization's annual conference in New York City.
