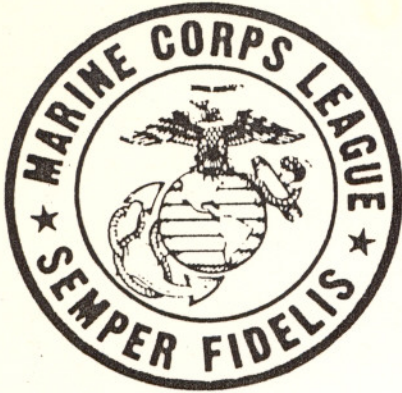
LOCAL MILITARY NEWS

The two Marines were based at the air station at Bodo, Norway in the Arctic Circle. Despite logistical and weather problems the exercise was a huge success. U.S. Marines worked with marines from Great Britain, Canada, and the Netherlands. Norwegian Army troops provided the resistance for the Amphibious Assault Exercises. Cpl Deitch and Lcpl Cutrone, both Aircraft Recovery Specialists, were involved in close air support operations.

Marine Aircraft Group-49 recieved their new SGTMAJOR, SGTMAJOR Brennen direct from Kaneoah Bay, Hawaii as SGTMAJOR Wilson departed for overseas duty.
