MARINES:

I KNOW IT HAS BEEN QUITE A SPELL SINCE I HAVE WRITTEN ANYTHING IN THIS NEWSLETTER AND PROBABLY YOU ALL SAY GOOD DEAL FOR THAT, HOWEVER HERE I GO AGAIN. AS YOU ALL KNOW WE GARNERED QUITE A FEW AWARDS AT THE STATE CONVENTION. THE TWO REASONS WE DID NOT RECEIVE THE AMERICANISM AWARD WAS OUR INACTIVITY IN THE V.A.V.S. PROGRAM. DON GEE AND MARLIN MILLER ARE WORKING ON THIS AS I WRITE. WHEN THE INFO COMES FORTH LET US GET INVOLVED. THE VETS THAT ARE HOSPITALIZED FOR THE MOST PART ARE PEOPLE WHO SERVED OUR COUNTRY AND SERVED WELL. LET US NOT FORGET OUR BROTHERS AND SISTERS WHO ARE HOSPITALIZED.

THE SECOND REASON IS THAT OUR OFFER FOR A DETACHMENT FLAG HAS BEEN LOST. AS YOU RECALL THIS IS A PRESENT FROM PAT AND I. AS SOON AS I GET THROUGH WITH THE SETTLEMENT ON OUR CONDO IN BEAUFORT, SC, I WILL PURSUE THIS AGAIN.

I WANT TO TALK ABOUT OUR YOUNG MARINES NOW. THIS UNIT IS NOT ONLY THE STAR IN EYES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PENNSYLVANIA BUT IS ALSO RIGHT THERE ALSO NOT IN THE NATION. I WANT TO THANK THE SOLEBURY TOWNSHIP CHIEF OF POLICE FOR ALLOWING OUR YOUNG MARINES TO DO THIS. I HAVE KNOWN THE CHIEF (DUFFY MANGAN) FOR A LOT OF YEARS AND HE HAS ALWAYS BEEN COMMUNITY MINDED. VOLUNTEER FIREMAN AND RESCUE SQUAD MEMBER FOR MANY YEARS AND HE ENJOYS HELPING OUR YOUNG MARINES. THE BUX-MONT YOUNG MARINES HAVE DONE SO MANY ACTIVITIES THAT ARE TOO NUMEROUS TO GO INTO. ANY ONE DESIROUS OF THEIR ACTIVITIES CALL ME AND I CAN FILL YOU IN MORE SPECIFICALLY.


